



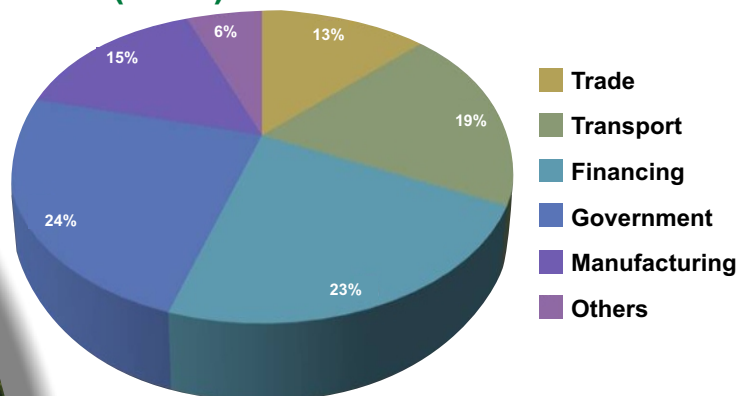
LEADING AFRICAN TRADE AND INVESTMENT CAPITAL
