THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS NEED TO COMPLY TO:

1. The noise level emitted from the property may not exceed 95 dBA.
2. A qualified acoustic engineer, must at all times during the event, take and record the emitted noise levels and hand a report containing the findings, to the Municipality within two (2) working days after the completion of the event. The engineers cost will be borne by the applicant.
3. The location of loudspeaker equipment should be taken into account in order to minimize noise emissions into the potentially noise sensitive areas.
4. The event should be advertised by means of leaflets or the media in order to inform the residents in the vicinity of the event.
5. Should you fail to comply with any of the above mentioned conditions, the consent will lapse.
