INVITATION TO THE COMMUNITY TO PROPOSE NAMES TO POPULATE THE GEOGRAPHICAL NAMES BANK

The Geographical Names Bank is a database consisting of approved geographical names for the City of Tshwane Metropolitan Municipality area. The approved names will be utilised to name public places and streets that have not been named yet. In order to populate the Geographical Names Bank the community of Tshwane is invited to submit proposed names for approval by Council.

Any person, community or organisation within the boundaries of the City of Tshwane Metropolitan Municipality is entitled to propose new names for the Geographical Names Bank.

All proposed names must be accompanied by information on the language of origin, meaning of the name and proof of the source of the name.
