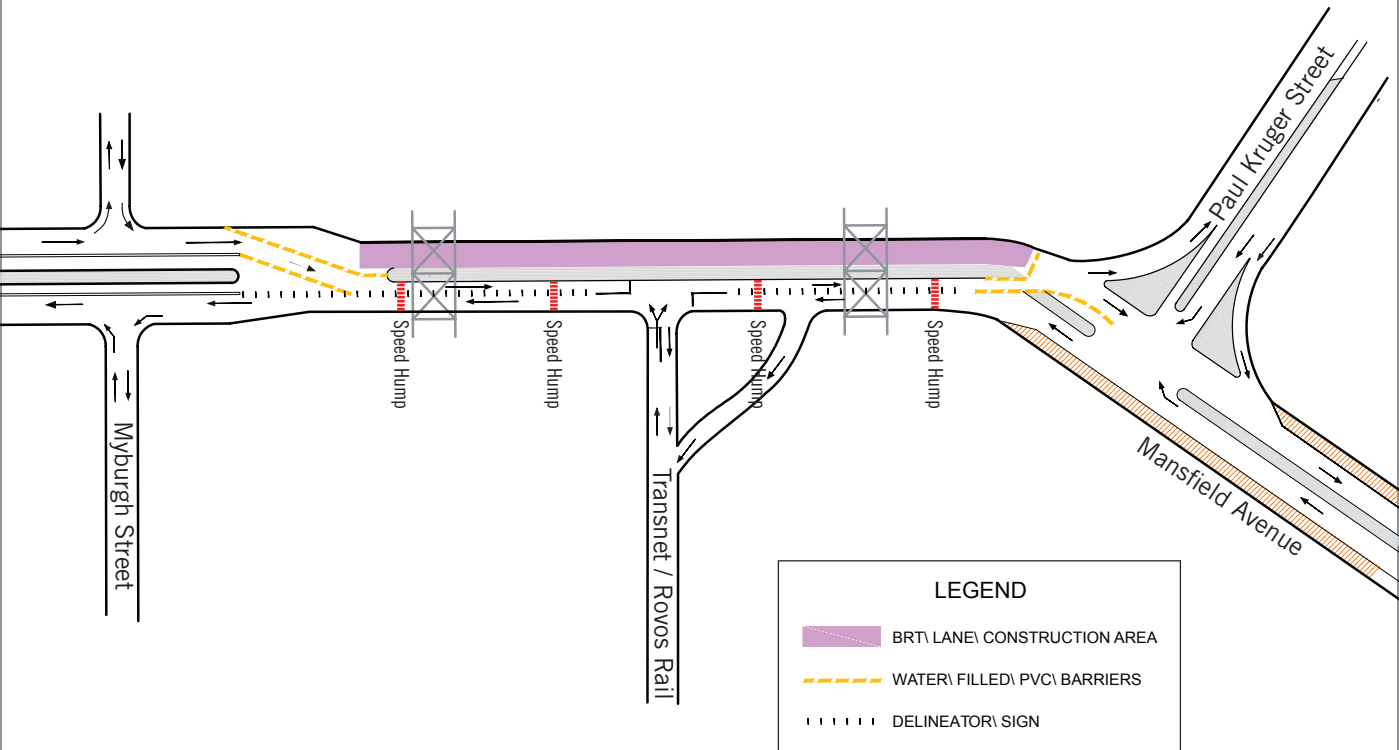


A Re Yeng Roadworks

Myburgh Street to Mansfield Avenue

21 January 2015 to end of July 2015



During November and December 2014 the contractor for the AReYeng project started preparation for the new bus lanes that will be constructed under the existing railway bridges in the Capital Park area. Construction will start on 21 January 2015 and continue until end of July 2015.

In order to safely construct the new AReYeng lanes on the existing northbound carriageway, all traffic will need to be diverted from the northern carriageway (heading towards Rainbow Junction) onto the southern carriage-

way (heading towards the inner city). This will result in only one lane of traffic in each direction during the construction phase.

The City of Tshwane thanks you for your cooperation during the construction period. We know that the traffic disruptions are frustrating and we are doing our best to complete construction in the area.

We also want to urge motorists to keep to the speed limits and obey the traffic signage. These have been implemented for the safety of the motorists and the workers on the site.
