QUALIFYING CRITERIA

- National Diploma: Environmental Health or equivalent qualification
- Registration with the Health Professions Council of South Africa (HPCSA) as an environmental health practitioner
- A valid driving licence with own vehicle
- Added advantage: Experience in municipal health services

PRIMARY FUNCTIONS

The environmental health practitioners are expected to work from Monday to Friday for eight hours per day within the scope of the following duties in order to ensure the implementation of an environmental health service according to policy and procedural directives:

- Food control
- Waste management
- Chemical safety
- Health surveillance of premises
- Prevention of communicable diseases
- Environmental pollution control
- Disposal of the dead
- Monitoring of water quality
- Vector control
