



Expression of interest to recruit 271 Peer Educators for the Ward-based Door-to-Door HIV, TB and STIs Education Programme of the Health Department to be appointed on a contract for a period not exceeding 12 months

Peer Educators (271 contract positions)

The City of Tshwane, in line with the national mandate on a multisectoral response to HIV, tuberculosis (TB) and sexually transmitted infections (STIs), implements a ward-based door-to-door education programme to mobilise, educate and inform communities about HIV, TB and STIs and link those in need to the relevant services.

Peer Educators will form part of the ward-based door-to-door HIV, TB and STIs education team, coordinated by the regional coordinators within the Multisectoral AIDS Response Management Section of the Health Department.

Qualifying criteria

- Grade 12
- People between the ages of 18 and 40 years
- Knowledge of HIV/AIDS, TB, STIs, substance abuse, stigma and other health and social matters, such as gender-based violence
- Numeric skills as well as good written and verbal communication skills
- Ability to speak local languages spoken within the wards
- Knowledge of different uses of electronic devices, such as texting messages, sending emails and using the internet
- Residing in the participating ward
- Proof of residence (a note from the ward councillor or municipal rates account statement)
- Must be willing to undergo a criminal record check and such a person shall allow their fingerprints to be taken by the Tshwane Metro Police Department at own cost
- If found to have a criminal record, the contract will be terminated

Primary function

To educate members of the community during door-to-door education and outreach campaigns in priority wards about HIV, TB, STIs, substance abuse, stigma and other health and social matters and to refer those in need to the relevant local services, including poverty relief, social support and healthcare according to their needs.

Key performance areas

Provide HIV, TB and STIs education at household and individual level through door-to-door visits and outreach campaigns and record all activities on the reporting stationery provided, as well as submitting reports timely.

Leading competencies

Collaboration; teamwork; respect; confidentiality; honesty; accountability; time management; organisational skills; ability to take initiative where necessary to achieve outcomes; emotional intelligence; sound judgement; ability to work independently and under pressure
